On March 28th the Waverley Country Club in Portland, Oregon played host to the inaugural Oregon Wine Awards featuring a prominent panel of respected wine professionals, buyers, writers and sommeliers who tasted and evaluated 257 Oregon wines in a single-blind format (meaning grape variety or wine style is known, but not the price nor producer) and awarded the top wines with Gold, Silver and Bronze Grand Awards of Excellence. The **2009 Outstanding Oregon Wine Award** honor those wines, which by panel consensus, were considered outstanding and eligible for the highest recognition of Gold, Silver, and Bronze Grand Award of Excellence.
