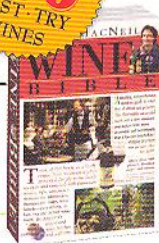

Champagne and french fries is such a delicious treat that it's hard to imagine breaking up the pair, but Anne Amie's fragrant lemon, vanilla, and pineapple scented pinot blanc is a wonderful—albeit richer—alternative to those zesty bubbles. Made from handpicked grapes in Oregon's famous Willamette Valley, it has a warm, brioche flavor that mirrors the savory, comforting flavors of crisp french fries. The wine also adds a layer of richness to meaty fish dishes like swordfish.
